

ENERGY CONSERVATION

The Board encourages and supports an energy conservation and energy education program in the school district to substantially lower the consumption of electricity, oil, gas, gasoline, water and other such products. Each district employee and student shall actively participate in the conservation efforts in order to reduce consumption to levels prescribed by local district and/or state and federal guidelines. However, every effort will be made to maintain programs for the benefit of students. The district administrators shall implement, direct, monitor, evaluate and report district energy conservation efforts. In addition, energy education programs should be incorporated in the appropriate areas of the district's curriculum.
