## **School of Agriculture Minority Summer Program June 7 & 8, 2012**

The William H. Darr School of Agriculture in collaboration with the City of Springfield will be conducting a two day summer program this coming 2012:

### **What does the Program Entail?**

The two day program is designed to help students get a better grip on college life and expose them to the academic side of college. The students will stay on campus for the 2 days. All expenses plus room and board will be defrayed by the program.

The students will be able to gain information through seminars given by speakers who have similar experiences and are key players in public and private endeavors. There will be Missouri State university speakers on Financial Aid, Career Planning, and Public Speaking.

Many of the professors and administrative personnel that work with the program will be the same ones that the students will work with once they have enrolled in college. Therefore, attending this program will further benefit the students by allowing them to meet mentors that will work with them during their full college tenure.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- The student must be a sophomore, junior or senior during the 2012-2013 school years.
- The student must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5.
- The students must have an interest in the broader sciences, but specifically agricultural related.

### **Benefits**

- Students will receive enlightenment and experience in college life
- Each student is eligible to receive a \$1,000.00 scholarship if they apply to MSU, and are admitted to the School of Agriculture
- Each student will receive a stipend of \$200.00 at the end of the two day period
