Missouri law requires that all children show proof of adequate immunizations. Recent changes in Missouri Law require that all incoming 8th graders have a Tdap vaccine unless they have received a Td booster within the last 2 years. All incoming kindergarteners and first graders are required to have 2 Varicella vaccines unless there is a documented chickenpox disease (a letter from your doctor is required).

According to our records your child will NEED the following immunization(s) to be in compliance.

According to State law, your child cannot enroll, pick up schedules, or attend school unless properly immunized. Students will be excluded from school August 25, 2011 unless proof of adequate immunization is presented to the school.

For your convenience a **FREE** immunization clinic will be held at the schools listed below. To participate in the on-site immunization clinic, you must do the following:

- 1. CALL HEALTH SERVICES 523-1632 TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT.**
- 2. Read the enclosed vaccine information sheets.**
- 3. Complete JORDAN VALLEY Immunization Consent form. Mark appropriate box(s) of vaccines that you give permission to be administered and then SIGN the form.**
- 4. ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO BRING THIS LETTER, WITH IMMUNIZATION RECORD AND ENCLOSED SIGNED CONSENT FORM AT THE TIME OF THE CLINIC.**

The FREE immunization clinic will be held at the following schools:

If you do not wish for your child to participate in the immunization clinic at school, your physician should be able to assist you in bringing your child's immunizations up to date or you may call the Springfield-Greene County Center for Immunization Services at 874-1220 to schedule an appointment. You will need to take this letter, with your child's immunization record book, to your physician or health department to be updated.

PLEASE RETURN COMPLETED IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION TO THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS BY AUGUST 2, 2011 AND TO MIDDLE SCHOOLS AND HIGH SCHOOLS BEFORE STUDENTS PICK UP THEIR FALL SCHEDULES.

Directions to Summer Immunization Clinics 2011

Kickapoo – Wednesday, July 27, 2011, 9:00 AM-12:30 PM (Tammy Holley)

ROOM 101: Go in the front entrance on the west (Jefferson St.). Go through the student center to the first hallway on the right. Clinic will be in Room 101—first room on the right.

Parkview – Thursday, July 28, 2011, 9:00 AM – 12:30 PM (Penny Goodwin)

Room 112: Park in the Meadowmere Street Parking Lot just north of building. Enter at the northeast main entrance. Clinic will be in Room 112.

Central –Friday, July 29, 2011, 9:00 AM –12:30 PM (Lynette Butler)

COMMONS AREA: Go in the new part of building to the commons area. The immunization clinic will be held in the faculty lunch room (Room 121).
