Our CCI Goals for Math – Recognize and Write Numbers 0-35. We had 45% of our students able to do this goal on the pretest. 95% of our class is able to count by 10's to 100. Along with the above goal, we are also working on Tens and Ones place value, and Recognizing and telling the value of Penny and Dime. An example of a place value problem would be—"How many tens and ones are in 32?" The answer I am looking for would be 3 Tens and 2 Ones. Or the child might say 3 bundles of Ten and 2 Single Ones. Our Language Arts Goal in Jan. was to be able to Spell 10 Sight Words. We had 45% able to do this on our Pretest.
